PREFERRED PLANS FOR FUTURE LAND USE AND TRANSPORTATION CHANGES ALONG MANCHESTER ROAD WILL BE PRESENTED AT PROJECT'S 4TH SERIES OF VISIONING SESSIONS

On March 9, 10, and 11 citizens from the West County area, including the communities of Ballwin, Ellisville, Manchester, Wildwood, and Winchester, will have an opportunity to view and provide comments on preferred land use changes, roadway improvements, and signage improvements developed based upon public input gathered from visioning sessions held in West County during November, December, and February. Attendees will have the opportunity to provide feedback via "keypad polling" as well as via written and in-person comments concerning the preferred plans for the Manchester Road corridor. The consultant team will incorporate this feedback as it prepares final recommendations for the Manchester Road Great Streets Project for presentation to the public in May. The final round of public meetings for the Manchester Road project in May will also discuss implementation strategies the five communities along the corridor can use to move forward with improvements over the next few years.

The preferred plans incorporate public input gathered at visioning sessions conducted over the last several months, as well as feedback from discussions with a range of stakeholders along the corridor and the technical analysis of the consultant team. These plans will illustrate in greater detail how Manchester Road will evolve over the next few decades within the corridor study area. The visioning sessions present a great opportunity to view the preferred plans in detail and offer feedback to the consultant team.

The consultant team retained by East West Gateway is charged with developing a Master Plan for an approximate 5-mile stretch of Manchester Road between Missouri Routes 141 and 109. Ultimately the municipalities involved (Ballwin, Ellisville, Manchester, Wildwood, and Winchester), as well as MoDOT and the West County Chamber of Commerce, can use the project's recommendations as a blueprint for considering roadway and other infrastructure improvements and economic development strategies along the corridor. The consultant team, lead by urban design and planning firm, Design Workshop, is looking at ways to improve infrastructure, manage traffic and parking, increase the potential for economic development, make the corridor safer for pedestrians, and enhance aesthetics in an environmentally responsible manner.

The goal is to make Manchester Road a Great Street and a great destination in West County.

All evening sessions will begin promptly at 7:00 p.m. Individuals wishing to participate in the polling must be seated by 7:30 p.m. for all evening sessions. Polling questions will be available on the project website at www.ewgateway.org/manchester beginning March 12, 2010. This will be an opportunity for those persons unable to attend one of the Visioning Sessions to give their input on the project.
